Revised Draft Plan Goals

- Be less restrictive as original draft plan
- Still discourage commuter traffic
- Discourage speeding
- Wait and see what impacts are



Revised draft plan (based on November meeting)

- Speed limit reduction
- Local access only signs
- Strategic stop sign placement
- Maintain restrictions at I 08th/Bellevue Way (AM and PM?)
- Maintain restrictions at SE I 6th/Bellevue Way (AM and PM?)
- Remove restrictions at I I 2th Ave SE and I I 3th Ave SE
- Routine data monitoring
- Message board signs directing traffic away from area



Revised Draft Plan Elements Under Consideration

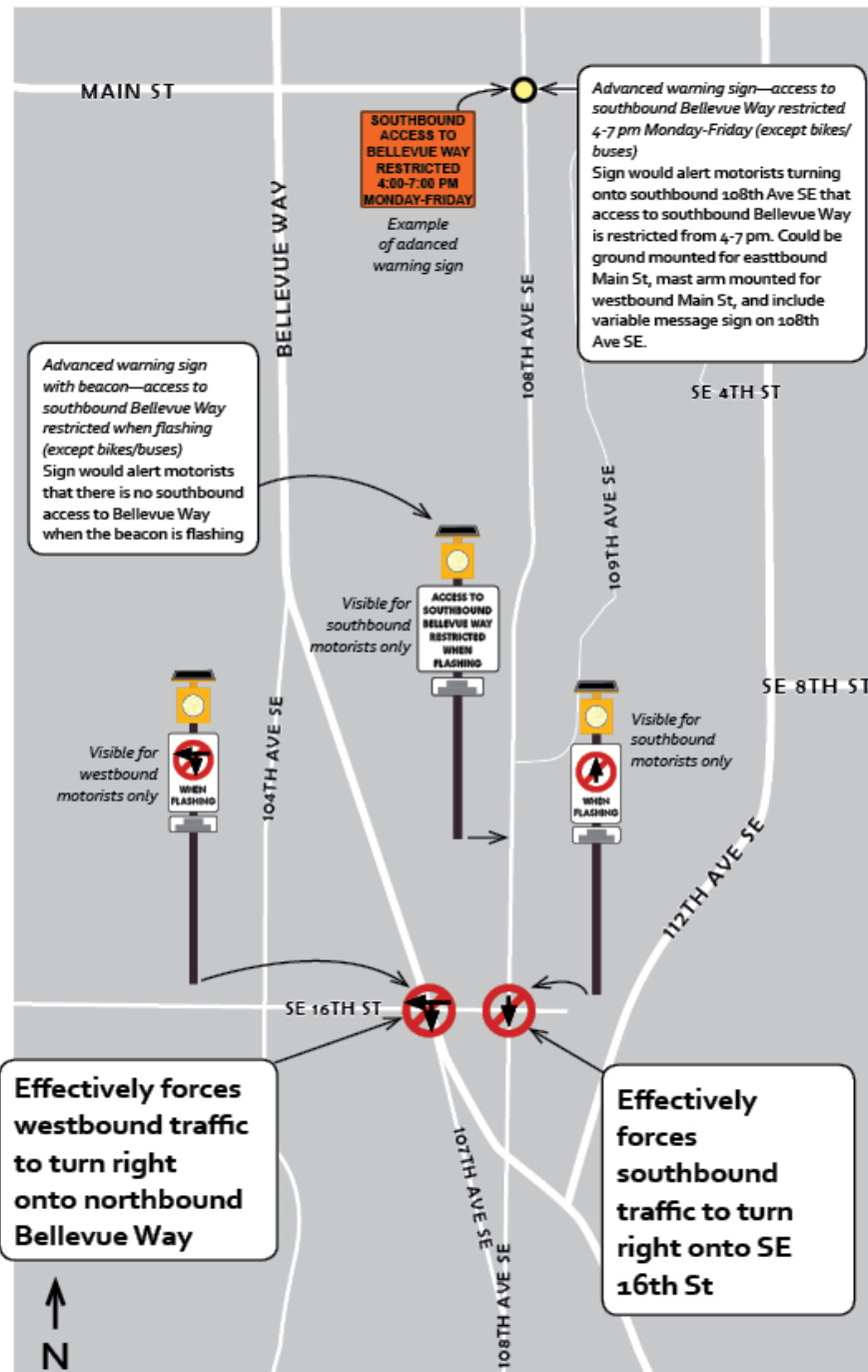
- Turn restrictions
 - Evening (3 month pilot):
 - No southbound through (toward Bellevue Way) on 108th Ave SE at SE 16th St
 - No left to southbound Bellevue Way on westbound SE 16th St
 - No straight (westbound) across Bellevue Way on SE 16th St
 - Morning:
 - No right (north) on 108th at Bellevue Way
 - No right (east) on SE 16th at Bellevue Way



Revised Draft Plan Elements Under Consideration

- Stationary radar signs—with volume collection
 - Southbound 108th (between Main and Bellevue Way)
 - Southbound 108th (between Bellevue Way and SE 34th St)
 - Southbound 104 south of Bellevue Way
 - Northbound 113th Ave SE south of Bellevue Way
- “Residential Area: Local Access Only signs” off arterials at
 - Southbound 101st/Main
 - Southbound 108th/Main
 - Southbound 108th/Bellevue Way
 - Southbound 107th/Bellevue Way
 - Southbound 104th/Bellevue Way
- Routine data collection
